This [Wheelchair Seating Mobility Curriculum](#) is designed as a ready-to-use curriculum for pre-professional PTs and PTAs. It is an education and training package with handouts, laboratory assignments, videos, and the ANPT Synapse Online Education 10-wheelchair courses to help prepare the entry-level workforce and increase the likelihood students are exposed to a minimal standard of knowledge and skills in WSM practice. By design, the program focuses on evaluation, prescription, and training to meet the needs of persons with basic level mobility impairments. A separate instructor guide provides resources, templates, and sample answers to assignments for approved faculty users. This is a collaborative project with the Craig H. Neilsen Foundation, Clinical Task Force, University of Hartford Department of Rehabilitation Sciences, and Rehabilitation & Technology Consultants.

For Legislative Action: Your action against the proposed 3.75% 2022 Medicare Physician Fee Pay Cuts and PTA Differential Cuts (15% cut in reimbursement of PTA provided outpatient services) is vital to our profession and our patients. For a deeper dive into these issues, use this [link](#).

- For the 3.75% 2022 Medicare Physician Fee Pay Cut: PTs, PTAs, students, and patients are asked to meet or contact their members of Congress to encourage them to provide additional funding to prevent these 2022 payment cuts.
- For the PTA Differential Cuts: PTs, PTAs, students, and patients are asked to meet or contact their members of Congress to encourage them to act to pass legislation to delay these cuts until 2023, provide an exemption for rural/underserved areas, and reduce the current burdensome direct supervision requirements in private practice settings.

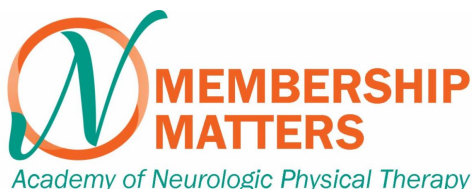
